Children will become aware of their place in space and in the space race.


Realization of their relationship to the cosmos hopefully will develop a sense of wonder, excitement and quest for the future.



Craters on the Moon



















New Moon

The New Moon can't be seen from the Earth's surface.

Waxing Gibbous

More than one-half of the Moon can be seen from the Earth's surface. The surface of the Moon that can be seen is increasing.

Waxing Crescent

A little less than one-half of the Moon can be seen from the Earth's surface. The surface of the Moon than can be seen is increasing.

Full Moon

The entire Moon can be seen from the Earth's surface.

First Quarter

One-half of the Moon can be seen from the Earth's surface. The surface of the Moon that can be seen is increasing.

Waning Gibbous

More than one-half of the Moon can be seen from the Earth's surface. The surface of the Moon than can be seen is decreasing.

Last Quarter


One-half of the Moon can be seen from the Earth's surface. The surface of the Moon that can be seen is decreasing.

Waning Crescent

A little less than one-half of the Moon can be seen from the Earth's surface. The surface of the Moon than can be seen is decreasing.


